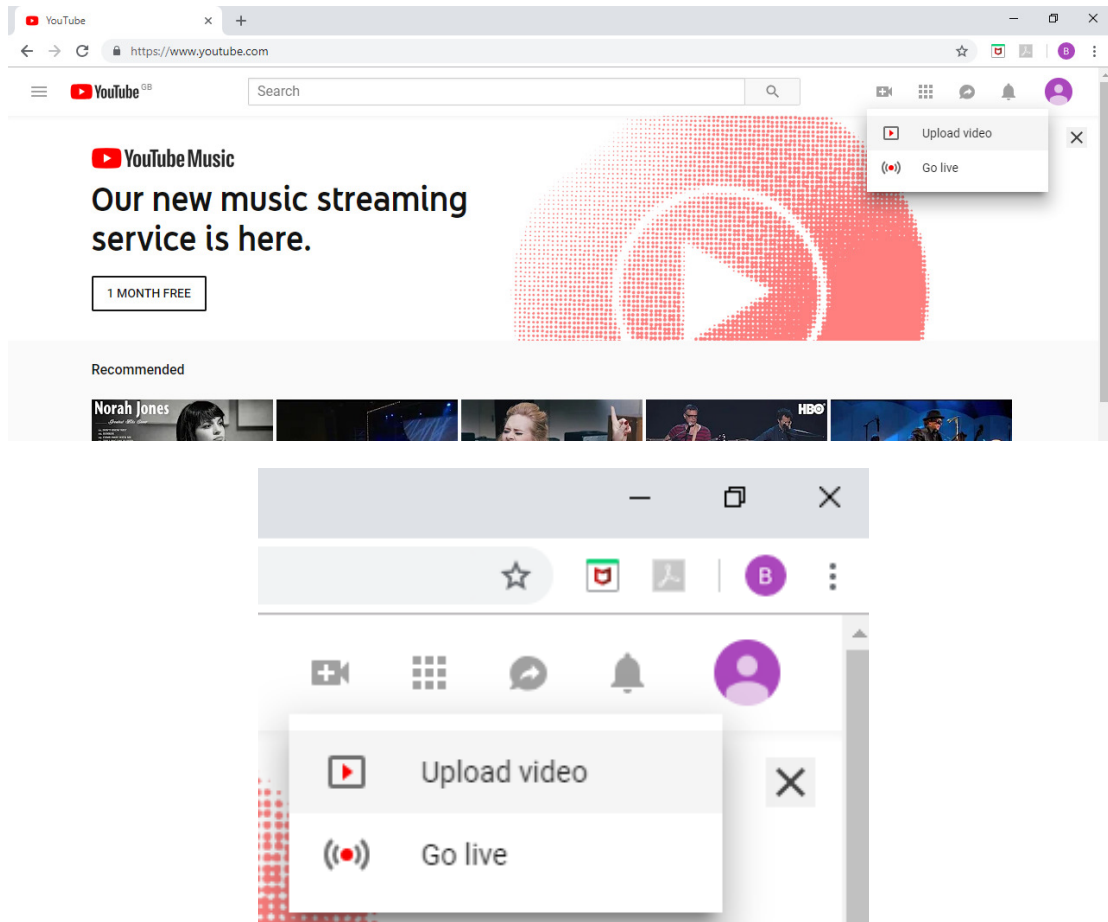


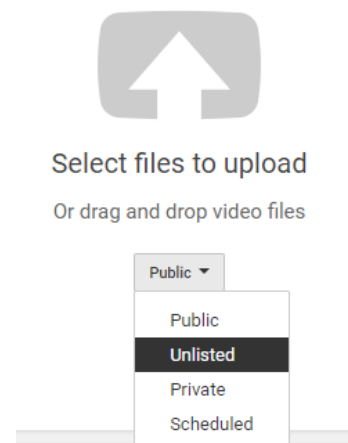
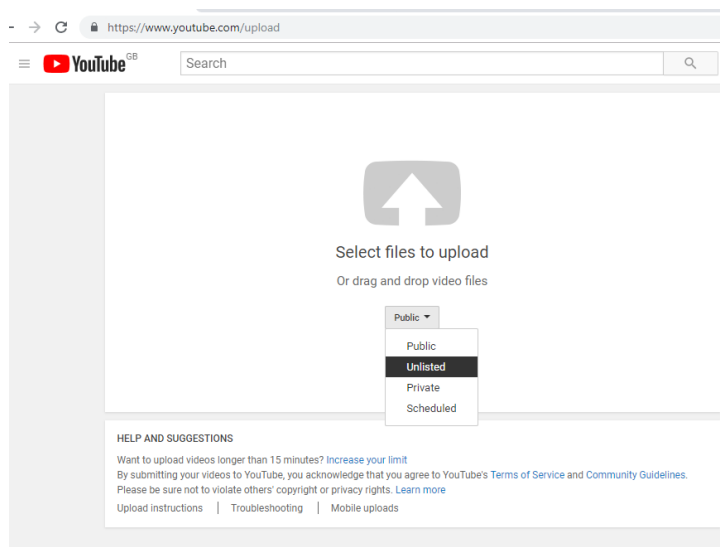
How to upload a video to YouTube and make it 'unlisted'

Making a video 'unlisted' means that only people who have been sent the link to the video can access it. You cannot search for it, and it will not come up on your list of videos.

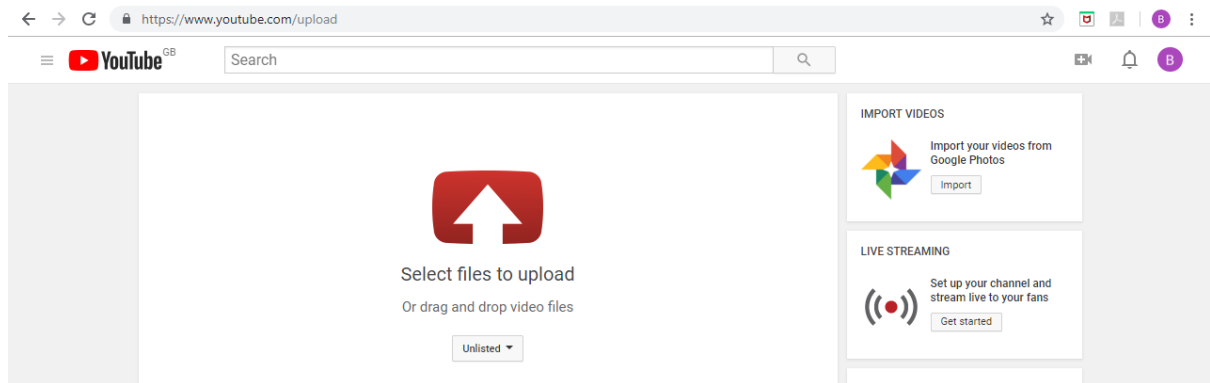
1. Once you have logged into your YouTube account (see separate instructions if you do not have an account), click on the icon of the video with the plus sign in the top right corner, and select 'Upload Video'



2. It will take you to a page to upload your video. Click the dropdown box and select 'Unlisted'

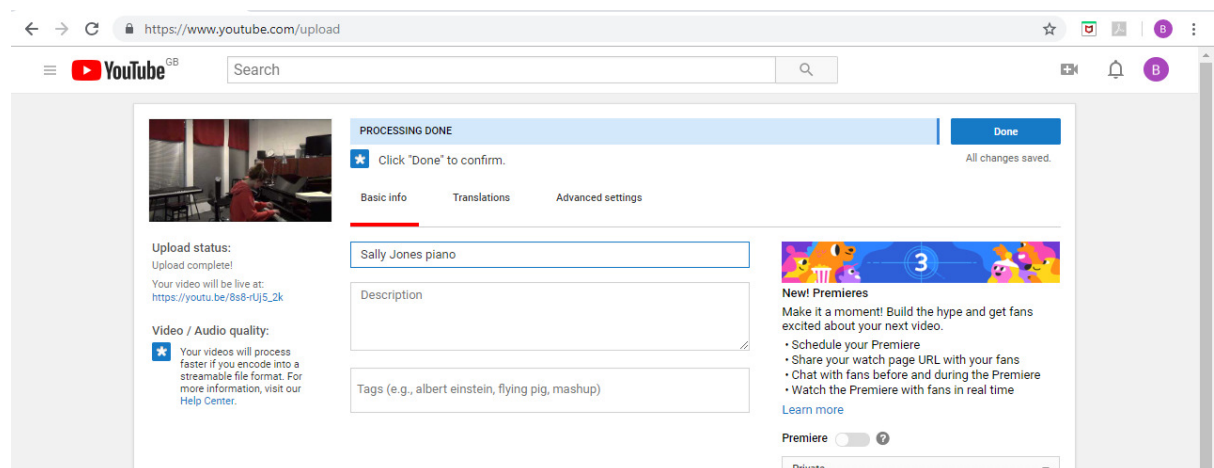


3. Click on the arrow and it should take you to your computer hard drive where you can select the relevant video.



4. Once you have selected the video to upload, it should take you to a page which looks like this:

Please make sure it is correctly labelled with their name and instrument!



5. You can then click 'Done' in the top right corner, and a page should come up with the link to your video:
