Coach Transfers

Airport coach leaving times are approximate. They will leave when passengers from the flight they are meeting have boarded the coach and a roll call has been carried out by the LSG Coach Marshall. Every effort will be made to contact any missing passengers but the coach will not be indefinitely delayed as the parking time is limited. It is the responsibility of the passengers to be at the meeting point/coach on time.

Our coaches will go to the front of the terminal (outside lane) only when the flights they are meeting have landed. Follow the signs in the airport to the coach boarding area (Level 0, Stands 9 & 10 at Gatwick South). Someone on each coach has agreed to be the LSG Coach Marshall responsible for asking the airport coach marshal to summon our coach. If you need to ask the airport coach marshal at Heathrow or Gatwick whether your coach has been called, please give him the number of the flight the coach is meeting, not your own.

1. Sunday, 20/8/17

Victoria Station (Central London) leaving at 11:30

Banstead Coaches will be behind the station in Bridge Place, outside the Doubletree Hotel.

Exit the station at the Wilton Road exit (far right from the mainline platforms or far left from the Underground exit), turn right and take first road on the right and you will see the hotel ahead of you on the left side of the road.

Refreshment stop.

London Gatwick Airport South Terminal leaving at 10:00

Banstead Coaches will meet Flight EZY8274 from Madrid arriving at 08:30 at the North Terminal (take the shuttle train to South Terminal). Refreshment stop.

London Gatwick Airport South Terminal leaving at 13:00

Banstead Coaches will meet Flight Fl470 arriving from Reykjavík at 11:45. If your flight lands at the North Terminal take the free shuttle train to South Terminal. Refreshment stop.

London Heathrow Airport Terminal 2 leaving at 13:00

Haines Minibus will meet Flight Fl450 from Reykjavík arriving at 11:15 Refreshment stop.
